



ENVIRONMENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SUPPLIERS

Without prejudice to the provisions contained in individual contracts, this document provides the environmental code of conduct that suppliers must observe in managing the environmental aspects of their activities when working at the offices/areas available to RAI WAY, based on that defined in the Environmental Management System adopted by RAI WAY.

Waste

Any waste produced by the supplier during their activities must be removed on the same work day it is produced. If this is not possible, the supplier must inform RAI WAY personnel of the type, hazardous characteristics and quantity of the waste and receive authorisation for temporary storage. The waste must be placed in the areas indicated by RAI WAY personnel and in a manner that avoids dangerous combinations and/or placement that could create dangers for the environment or for workers. The supplier is responsible for removing the deposited waste within the terms and using the methods established under current legislation and in any case upon request by RAI WAY.

Noise

The supplier undertakes to use equipment with noise emission levels suited to the urban area in which the RAI WAY offices are located and, in any case, to work so as to prevent any problems relative to noise emissions (e.g. using quieter equipment, working hours in line with an urban context, etc.).

Hazardous substances

If a supplier must use chemical substances in executing the work assigned by RAI WAY, the supplier must inform RAI WAY personnel, providing the technical specifications for said products. The supplier undertakes not to store any type of chemical substance at RAI WAY sites. If storage is necessary, the supplier must obtain information from RAI WAY about the presence of specific areas for storing these substances, which will in any case be stored by the supplier so as to avoid environmental pollution and risks to workers. In addition, the supplier undertakes to provide RAI WAY with the technical specifications of installed equipment when the equipment arrives, in particular with regards to the presence of any chemical substances contained therein.

Spills

While executing the work assigned by RAI WAY, the supplier must act so as to avoid spilling products in a liquid state that may be used or found inside equipment used or installed (e.g. oil, coolants, etc.). If a spill is accidentally caused, the supplier must promptly act to eliminate or minimise the effects as far as possible, immediately informing RAI WAY personnel.
